

## **TO WARWICK:**

### **From BIRMINGHAM AIRPORT:**

**TRAIN:** Several train routes connect Birmingham Airport and Warwick station (WRW) [Note: Make sure to select Warwick Station (WRW) and NOT Warwick Parkway (WRP).] The total journal time can vary from 45 mins to 1h 20 mins, depending on which train route you take. Once you know your arrival time at Birmingham airport, check the train options on the [Trainline](#) website.

**CAR:** 30 minutes taxi.

### **From: LONDON HEATHROW**

**TRAIN:** London Heathrow to Warwick (WRW) via Marylebone:

[Note: When planning a journey using the 'Transport for London' [website](#) or [app](#), option 1 often comes up as the preferred route. However, look closely at the details of the journey as it sometimes involves a longer walk or a bus journey. For this reason, I'd suggest favoring option 2 or 3 instead of option 1.]

- 1) **Option 1:** Heathrow Express (from Terminals 2&3, or 5) to Paddington station. Transfer to Paddington underground and take tube (Hammersmith & City line, pink) to Marylebone. Total journey time 40 mins.
- 2) **Option 2:** Piccadilly underground line (dark blue; from Terminals 2&3, 4 or 5) to Piccadilly Circus. Then transfer to Bakerloo underground line (brown) from Piccadilly Circus to Marylebone. Total journey time 50 mins.
- 3) **Option 3:** Elizabeth underground line (purple; from Terminals 2&3, or 5) to Paddington. Then transfer to Hammersmith & City line (pink) to Marylebone. Total journey time 32 mins.

From, Marylebone, take direct train (no changes needed) via Chiltern Railways

(<https://www.chilternrailways.co.uk/>) to Warwick. Make sure to select Warwick Station (WRW) and NOT Warwick Parkway (WRP).

Train journey takes approx. 1h 30 mins.

Departs roughly every hour, from 08:00 until 22:08 on Sunday, August 21.

Departs roughly every hour, from 06:06 until 23:07 on Monday, August 22.

**BUS:** From London Heathrow:

Take the National Express coach (<https://book.nationalexpress.com/>) to Coventry (Pool Meadow Bus Station).

Note – some of the coaches are direct; others require one change.

Bus journey takes approx. 3h 40m

Departs roughly every 30mins, from 06:35 until 18:25 on Sunday, August 21.

Departs roughly every 30mins, from 06:20 until 18:20 on Monday, August 22.

From Coventry Pool Meadow Bus Station, options for travel into central Warwick are:

- (a) Taxi – journey time 20mins
- (b) Bus X18 – 5 min walk from Pool Meadow to bus stop, then 49 min bus journey into Warwick.
